Pursuant to Energy Efficiency Guidance Document EE-12: EEPS 2 Audit Plan, from the Director of the Office of Clean Energy, and at the request of Department of Public Service Staff ("Staff"), National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("Distribution" or the "Company") submits this letter to notify the Commission and Staff that the 2012-2015 Low Income Usage Reduction Program ("LIURP") is no longer active and has been replaced with the Company's 2016-2018 Energy Efficiency Transition Implementation Plan ("ETIP") LIURP Program. Please update the EEPS Reporting Application to reflect that the 2012-2015 phase of the program has ended. Distribution has completed all committed projects for LIURP.
